Bluegrass Coolmore-bred colt is the first foal out of the 2016 Commonwealth Cup and Haydock Sprint Cup winner Quiet Reflection, winner of eight of her 13 starts; dam never raced beyond 6f, but no great surprise to see the Galileo colt starting off at 7f; of obvious interest.

Brown Eagle Unable to make any impression when 66-1 first time out at Galway, can be ruled out.

Cowboy Justice No match for Beauty Inspire first time out over 6f at this venue, but that form reads well seeing that the winner landed the Group 3 Anglesey Stakes comfortably on his second start; unlikely to be far away.

Craic At Dawn Dawn Approach colt, brother to two winners for the stable and a half-brother to two others; four-time winner Dawn Hooper best of the four.

Jack Rose Second foal; half-brother to a minor middle-distance winner; dam failed to win; half-sister to Kevin Prendergast-trained 6f/7f Listed winner Rose Bonheur; others appeal more.

Mr Trinket Second foal out of a French AW winner; some signs from the pedigree that he could prosper over further in the long term; family of Generous.

Music Magic Half-brother to five winners, best of them Mubtasim a five-time winner effective at 6f/7f and rated 112 at his best; has been gelded.

Shaky Operator 13th foal; half-brother to nine winners including a US 5f Grade 3 scorer; second-string for the trainer of Cowboy Justice.

Shark Bay Placed in maidens at this venue on his first two starts; did not find as much as might have been expected when fourth in a Listed event at Tipperary on Friday.

Strike Eagle Half-brother to three American winners; faces tough assignment first time out.

Swan Bay 110,000gns yearling; third foal; half-brother to a minor 1m winner; dam US 7f AW winner.

Von Krolock Dam did most of her racing over 6f and won four times; tough introduction here with so many of the top stables involved

Fools Glory Home-bred filly from a small yard; half-sister to three winners including a UAE Listed scorer; tongue-tie fitted, best watched.

Missy Zippy Half-sister to two winners may struggle to hold her own against colts from leading yards.

VERDICT With the advantage of a run **COWBOY JUSTICE** may take the measure of **Bluegrass**, a Galileo colt whose dam was a top-class sprinter. **Shark Bay**, placed on his first two starts, was fourth in a Listed event at Tipperary on Friday and might not be asked to turn out again now. [Alan Sweetman]

Corviglia Soft ground was probably not ideal first time out at Listowel; improved considerably when winning in promising style over 7f at Leopardstown; could make a race of it with the other previous winner Concert Hall.

Cairde Go Deo Showed definite potential first time out, finishing 5l clear of the third when chasing home a smart-looking type over 1m at Leopardstown; missed her engagement at Tipperary on Friday due to change in going.

Livia Celeste Group-placed dam (a sister to Rock Of Gibraltar) has a modest record as a broodmare thus far, but this filly showed potential when a never-nearer fourth on her debut at Leopardstown having reared up leaving the stalls; entitled to have learned plenty from that run, although drop to 7f may not be ideal.

Nectarine Has not enjoyed much luck in her last two races, but nothing to suggest she could win a race of this standard; no surprise that she is rejected by Kevin Manning in favour of Tostal.

She's Evaporust Big price when finishing towards the rear on debut at this venue in June; looks out of her depth.

Esculenta Sixth foal; half-sister to a Flat and hurdles winner, dam French Listed-placed 1m winner; others make more appeal on pedigree, faces a stern test in this company on debut.

History Cost 2,800,000gns as a yearling; Galileo filly is the first foal out of a US Grade 2 winner; dam is a sister to 1m Group 1 winner Mohaather, half-sister to the dam of Group 1 winner Accidental Agent; of obvious interest, but Ryan Moore prefers the twice-raced Concert Hall.

Onameridance Is a half-sister to two winners; dam 1m-1m6f winner, is out of a half-sister to French Derby winner Anabaa Blue; may not prove as dangerous as once-raced stablemate Livia Celeste.

Rancho Santa Fe 460,000gns yearling; third foal; dam unraced half-sister to French Derby winner Reliable Man, Australian 1m2f Group 3 winner Imposing and French 1m4f Listed winner Gale Force.

Tostal Dam was of little account but has produced two winners; selected of stable's two runners, that no surprise since the other one has not shown much; stable won this five times in a row between 2007 and 2011, but no success since.

VERDICT Aidan O'Brien has won this race with some smart fillies in the past. Course and distance scorer **CONCERT HALL** may give him a first success since the talented Hydrangea in 2016. She could be tested by Leopardstown winner **Corviglia** and **Cairde Go Deo**, who showed promise on her debut and missed an engagement in a Listed race at Tipperary on Friday. Expensive yearling purchase **History** may need this introductory run. [Alan Sweetman]

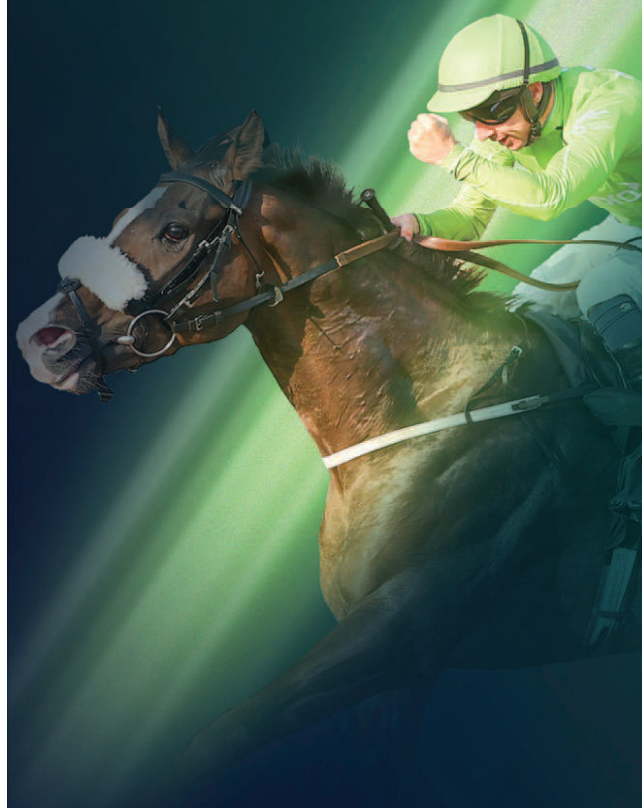

Dame Shelby Mixed signals from pedigree; half-sister to a sprint winner, dam stayed middle distances; lack of experience a drawback.
Dont Tell The Bear Finished in midfield on debut at Fairyhouse; not given a hard race and should improve, but hardly by enough to win a maiden at this venue.
Edge Of My Seat First of her two 7f Gowran runs was better than her second; will need a handicap mark.
Elanora Placed in three of her eight races; no sign of progression since Naas second in May; has a bit to find with Punakha on running at Gowran on her penultimate start.
Fascinating Secret First foal out of a French winner with an interesting pedigree; hooded here for debut; possibly worth a look for future reference.
Glandore Harbour Fourth foal; half-sister to two 5f winners, including Listed scorer Orlaith; dam unraced half-sister to 7f juvenile Group 1 winner Toormore and 7f Group 2 winner Estidhkaar; EUR100,000 yearling comes from a yard enjoying a good spell of form.
Khlass Two runs at Leopardstown; looked in need of further than this on debut; encountered some trouble in running in 1m1f maiden on second start.
Micromoon Obtained initial experience in a barrier trial; finished a clear second-best behind a 92-rated filly at Gowran on official debut; has the beating of fourth-placed My Holy Fox on that running; holds leading chance.
My Holy Fox Made debut at Dundalk in March; was entitled to need her recent Gowran run after a break, but has 4 3/4l to find with Micromoon and may struggle to turn the tables.
Punakha Went very close against at 85-rated rival over this trip at Gowran on second start; did not quite last out the 1m trip at Killarney, fading into sixth after a prominent showing; visored now.
Rosa Woodsii Second in Naas fillies' maiden last September was promising; a shade disappointing on seasonal return at Bellewstown, though not knocked about once beaten; should come on for that run.
Zumoradda Reverts to maiden company after four handicap outings this term; touched off at Roscommon in May before fair third at Leopardstown; found to be blowing hard after Roscommon failure; restored to form when third in 15-runner Galway handicap 13 days ago, finishing out the race to good effect after receiving an early check; should be thereabouts.

VERDICT No match for a 92-rated rival at Gowran, **MICROMOON** may not need to improve a great deal in order to win here. He enjoys an edge over **My Holy Fox** and possibly has more potential for improvement than rivals such as **Punakha**, **Zumoradda** and **Rosa Woodsii**. [Alan Sweetman]

Harry's Bar Nine-time all-weather winner (five times at this trip) who raced on turf only rarely during his time with James Fanshawe; second in a 5f Naas Listed event in April was encouraging; but has struggled on last two starts, in the King's Stand and when last of 16 in a Listed race last time; up against it here; tongue-tie tried now.
Ventura Rebel Won Group 3 over course and trip last September, with Romantic Proposal back in fourth; campaigned at a high level this season; not at his best at Newcastle since contesting the Diamond Jubilee Stakes.
A Case Of You Boasts an excellent strike-rate (4-7); Anglesey Stakes winner for his previous trainer at two, and has continued to prosper; beat Power Under Me in a Group 3 on soft ground at Naas in May; reported to have lost a shoe when contesting the Commonwealth Cup; first time with tongue-tie.
Romantic Proposal Has progressed well this term, reaching the first three on all four starts; beat Teresa Mendoza and Quarantine Dreams in Listed 6f event here in June; has a bit to find with Gustavus Weston on most recent running in a 5f Group 2 event here.
Light Refrain Better may have been expected in the Jersey Stakes at Royal Ascot, but overall form this season reveals a high standard of form; has obtained a Listed win, a Group 2 fourth at Haydock (in a race that has worked out well) and a Group 3 win at York last month; solid chance of another victory in this highly competitive affair.
Power Under Me Debut winner of Naas maiden last October and returned there for next two starts, notably Group 3 Lacken Stakes in May; promoted to second then behind A Case Of You after being hampered in the closing stages; saw out 7f trip when third in a Group 2 last time, but not short of speed.
Quarantine Dreams Fifth, beaten over five lengths, in a Listed race at Cork yesterday; others make more appeal at this level.
The Highway Rat Has made his name with three wins at Dundalk; rated 79 at the start of the year, has climbed a total of 25lb in the interim; deserves to take his chance but may find this opposition a bit too demanding on grass.
Teresa Mendoza Performing well in defeat this term including second behind Romantic Proposal here in June; however, she is the only runner whose rating is not in three figures and she faces a hard task in the circumstances.

VERDICT All but two of these rivals carry an official rating between 104 and 108, giving a very open complexion to this Group 3 event. The 2019 winner **Gustavus Weston** should be in the mix again, but slight preference is for last month's York Group 3 winner **LIGHT REFRAIN**. There is very little to choose between **A Case Of You** and **Power Under Me** on their clash at Naas in May. [Alan Sweetman]

Jon Riggins Progressive for Sean Hennessy and has moved to the master trainer of sprinters; travelled best of all in 5f Tipperary maiden in June before having to settle for second; big player.

Manizales Muhaarar colt who was sixth of 14 in 5f Dundalk maiden last November on sole start; needs more.

Mr Pc Stepped up on tame enough Fairyhouse debut to take fourth in 6f Cork maiden last month; showed speed there so no surprise to see him try the minimum trip; that said, others preferred.

Mulgrave One spot and 1l ahead of Mr Pc in a 6f Cork maiden 16 days ago; that was a step in the right directions but RPRs suggest he still has a bit to find; blinkers on for the first time.

Swift Flight More experienced than most in here and has some of that best form too having bumped into Van Gogh last year; has 1 3/4l to make up on Jon Riggins from their Tipperary tussle back in June, though.

Valhalla's Dream This will be the seventh start for the son of Morpheus whose last two starts have been disappointing in handicaps; back in a maiden now but mark of 69 suggest he is fighting for place-money at best.

Blue Umbrella A 11-race maiden rated 57; disappointing last twice and hard to fancy here.

Kilbhin Lady Hasn't progressed since Cork fourth in 6f maiden on debut in June; backward steps the last twice; others make more appeal.

Marali Shauday An Elzaam filly who is a half-sister to a 7f winner and shaped with promise in a barrier trial at Dundalk when only a couple of lengths behind River Eden and Wrens Breath who has proved themselves to be above-average since; could outrun her odds

Notoriously Risky Has been a beaten favourite on her last three outings but posted an RPR of 84 in a 6f Naas handicap in May and a repeat of that performance would make her hard to beat here; solid effort latest over C&D but doesn't always find as much as expected when push comes to shove; obvious contender nonetheless.

Red Wasp Newcomer; Coulsty filly; cost 24,000 euros as a yearling; dam unraced sister to Listed-placed 5f/7f winner Flying Sparkle.

VERDICT **Notoriously Risky** has been a beaten favourite on her last three outings and could top the market again here. She has solid claims but the identically-rated **JON RIGGENS** has more scope for improvement on his first start for Eddie Lynam so gets the vote instead. **Swift Flight** should go well too. [David Jennings]

Castle Star Runner-up on his first two starts; showed signs of developing into a top-class colt with two course wins, the first in a 5f maiden in early-May; backed that up with a smooth victory in the Marble Hill; had to be switched to challenge in the Railway Stakes and was beaten 1 1/4l by Go Bears Go; looks sure to go close in an intriguing rematch.

Dr Zempf 420,000gns yearling made a favourable impression when winning first time out at this venue at the beginning of June; did not get the best of runs when fourth in the Railway Stakes; started favourite then, so it will be interesting to see how the market assesses his chance of turning the tables on Go Bears Go and Castle Star.

Ebro River Won the Listed 5f eveny in fine style on soft going at Sandown in May despite hanging badly left; has been performing with credit at Group 2/3 level since then; fifth in the Coventry, close-up fourth in the July Stakes and same again in the Richmond at Goodwood ten days ago; not beaten far in those three races; needs to raise his game now.

Go Bears Go Cost 150,000gns at Craven breeze-up in April; knew his job and made all on debut over 5f at Ascot; returned to that venue to boost his reputation with a fine second in the Norfolk Stakes; won Railway Stakes quite decisively, enjoying a smoother passage through the race than Castle Star and Dr Kempf; sets the standard, but will have to be on top of his game.

Strapped Won Cork maiden on second start; raced prominently before weakening into third behind Castle Star in the Marble Hill; ended up with only one behind him when 50-1 in the Railway Stakes.

The Entertainer Navan debut win came over extended 5f, safely held in much better company since at this track, testing ground probably not ideal in Marble Hill; down the field in the Railway Stakes, and well beaten in a Group 3 here last time.

Twilight Jet Tipperary winner on third start after failing to make much impact behind Castle Star in the Marble Hill; satisfactory run when seventh in the Norfolk Stakes; needs to reverse Railway Stakes form with three opponents, which seems an unlikely prospect.

Prettiest First foal out of three-time Group 1 winner Alice Springs; won a maiden first time out at Navan in May; testing conditions probably not ideal when creditable fourth in the Albany at Royal Ascot; can be excused Leopardstown reverse, since she was found to be in season; last filly to win this was La Collina at 33-1 for Kevin Prendergast in 2011.

VERDICT It might be a mistake to rule out **Prettiest**, who had an excuse last time, or **Ebro River** who has been running well in Group 2 races. However, this revolves primarily around the form of the Railway Stakes.

Castle Star and **Dr Kempf**, second and fourth respectively in that event, will be tough opponents for **GO BEARS GO** who is tipped to come out on top again. [Alan Sweetman]

Tyrconnell Dundalk specialist who has won six times on the all-weather; fifth of nine at Down Royal on return to grass last month; others make more appeal off their marks.

Comfort Line Ran twice at Galway and second run was better, staying on to finish in mid-division in 7f handicap; dropped 2lb since and mark of 89 catches the eye on the best of his form, especially Lincoln third off 2lb higher; could make his presence felt here.

Ice Cold In Alex Loves it here and can never be discounted in this sort of contest; fifth of 19 in 6 1/2f handicap here last month having won 7f handicap at the track the previous month; up to a mark of 88 but boasts solid each-way claims once again here.

Eagle's Flight In-form 4yo miler who produced another solid effort in 1m handicap at Killarney last time off this mark when a close-up third to Roca Roma; fourth over C&D prior to that; should go well.

Juyush Rattled off three wins in a row last winter at Dundalk over a mile off marks of 64, 73 and 80; travelled well for a long way at Fairyhouse last time; due to run at Tipperary on Friday night.

Turbulence Made it third time lucky in Killarney maiden over this trip last month when springing a 22-1 surprise; handicapper has taken no chance with opening mark of 84; unexposed and stable going really well.

Gegenpressing Won a Limerick claimer (6 1/2f, good) for Ger Lyons before joining current yard; seemed to find 7f too sharp on stable debut at Down Royal so extra furlong will suit here; others might be better handicapped.

MK Drama Just the sole success from 21 starts and only beat one home at Gowran Park (1m, good) when last seen 15 days ago; best to look elsewhere.

Star Image Having her first start since running in a Listed race at Newmarket last October; some snippets of form make her interesting here off a mark of 80; more interesting than most.

No More Porter Running from 1lb out of the handicap but arrives here in top form; decisive scorer in 6 1/2f handicap here in June off 61 and has been placed twice since off higher marks, including last time at Leopardstown when upped to this trip for the first time; could have a say.

VERDICT Toshizou is probably the most interesting of these but he's back from a break so might be best watched for something later in the campaign. **COMFORT LINE** (nap) was third in the Lincoln here in March off a mark of 91 and makes plenty of appeal off 2lb lower. Although only eighth in the Ahonoora Handicap at Galway, there was plenty to like about the way he hit the line and this is his third run after a little mid-summer break so he should be coming to the boil nicely. 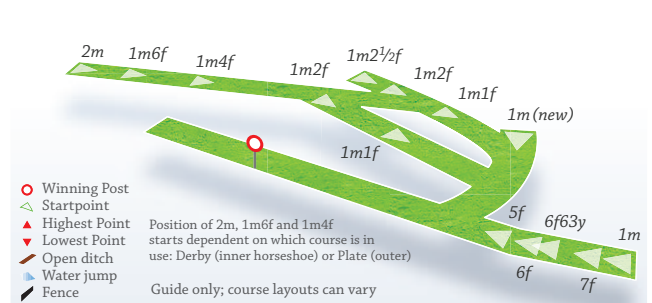

Ramiro Three wins from 12 starts; narrowly landed 7f Limerick handicap last month despite idling in the closing stages; up 4lb and down in trip.
Pretty Boy Floyd Relishes soft ground and enjoyed conditions when winning 5f Haydock handicap in May off 74; couldn't land a blow in Rockingham last time but foolish to rule out if the rain arrives.
Mickey The Steel A seven-race maiden and has cut little ice this term; would warrant consideration if back to the sort of form he showed last autumn when runner-up three times in a row and posting RPRs of 83, 82 and 85; ground too quick at Navan latest.
Miss Molly T Sole success arrived in 7f Leopardstown maiden last October; chased home Independent Missy at Navan in April and not beaten far on two starts since over 7f; has the pace to cope with this trip in trip and champion jockey rides for his father.
Linda Barrett Navan maiden winner in March who has held her own in a few decent handicaps since then, most notably when third to the speedy Logo Hunter at Cork; outclassed in Group 3 last time but this should be more her cup of tea.
Trueba Four-time winner who received an early bump at Naas last time when fifth off this mark; 9lb higher than last winning mark at Limerick in June.
Mogwli Made a decent fist of it from the front at Naas (6f, good) last time; same mark here and place claims under 10lb claimer with conditions fine.
Screen Siren Off the mark in 5f Cork handicap in June off a mark of 71; a little unlucky next time at Naas but only eighth over 5f here last time; only having her ninth start so not yet fully exposed and ground conditions shouldn't pose a problem.

Dragons Call Strong-travelling sprinter who has dropped to a very attractive mark; was rated 84 this time last year so 20lb lower now; has gone very short in running on last two starts without getting the job done but Chris Hayes takes over in the saddle and looks sure to give a good account.
Resourceful Man Has only had the five starts and promising effort at Dundalk in July when last seen; did some decent late work there and mark of 67 makes him of some sort of interest here; fourteenth at Cork yesterday.
VERDICT DRAGONS CALL has hit lows of 1.22 and 1.84 on the exchanges on her last two starts but hasn't managed to get the job done. She doesn't always find much off the bridle but has slid all the way down to a mark of 64 and Chris Hayes takes over in the saddle so is worth persevering with.
